#### About Weeks

  - 2. Special week
- Counter of both types of weeks will be seen in students log in

## 1. Normal Week

- \* In students dashboard its counter is named as "Total Weeks"
- It shows how many weeks student has to give all the tests
- \* This is set by MKCL

## ... 1. Normal Week

- \* Rules in Normal weeks:
- 1. Student can give 1 Chapter wise Test per subject per week
- 2. Student can give 1 Combo Test per subject per week
- 3. Student can give one Re-attempt of every test
- 4. Student can give any number of "Re-attempt" tests per week

## 2. Special Week

\* 10 Special weeks would be available

- \* Student can make any week a special week by simply giving more than 1 chapter wise test of any subject
- \* If student gives more than one fresh chapter wise test, then that week will be converted to special week

## ... 2. Special Week

 Whenever student will select more than one Fresh Chapter wise test to give in a week then such message will appear

## ... 2. Special Week

- \* Once student decides to make a particular week as special week then student can;
- Give 3 Fresh Chapter wise tests per subject per week
- 2. Give1 Combo Test per subject per week
- 3. Can give any number of "Re-attempt" tests

#### **About Tests**

\* There are 3 types of tests available for students

- 1. Chapter wise tests
- 2. Combo tests
- 3. Reattempt test
- 4. Full Portion tests

## 1. Chapter wise tests

- There will be a test on all the chapters of PCMB there in the syllabus
- In normal week only 1 chapter wise test per subject can be given
- In special week 3 chapter wise tests per subject can be given

#### 2. Combo test

- Automatically gets generated
- It will have portion of all the tests given by student in previous weeks for that subject
- Example: If Student has given Test A of Physics in first week then gives Test B of Physics in second week, then combo test of "A+B" will get generated in third week

#### 3. Re-attempt

- \* Student can re attempt all the tests he/she gives
- \* They can give these re attempts anytime they want
- \* Only one re attempt is allowed

## 4. Full Portion tests

- \* From November, Full portion tests will be made available in student's log in
- \* 28 such tests will be made available
- Portion will comprise of both 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> standard syllabus i.e. JEE Main syllabus
